

Science Quiz/Test Corrections

Quiz and Test corrections are a way to earn back some points on a Quiz or Test. For each correctly completed correction, you can earn back half the point value of a missed question. (For example, if you missed a 4 point question, you can earn 2 points back. If you missed 1 point on a question, you can earn $\frac{1}{2}$ point back.) To receive any points, the following must be included for every problem:

1. **The problem number.**
2. **The correct answer and an explanation of WHY it is correct.**
3. **Your original answer and an explanation of WHY it is incorrect.**

Remember, you are trying to prove to me that you deserve some credit for problems you got wrong. You need to make me believe that you really understand it now.

Example:

#7 ← Problem Number

Correct Answer and Explanation

The correct answer is D, matter is anything that takes up space and has mass. This is the definition of matter. Mass is a measure of how much stuff (atoms!) is in something and how much space something takes up is called volume.

Original (Incorrect) Answer and Explanation

I chose A, matter is everything in the universe. This is not true, because matter has to have mass and volume, but not everything does. Things like sound, gravity, and love are not matter, but they are in the universe.
