Here are some ideas on what you can do to prepare for quizzes and tests.

• Study your Yellow Folder notes.

 Don't just read them. Try having someone quiz you. Or, cover up parts of the notes and see if you can tell what would be there.

• Rewatch the EdPuzzles.

 Pause frequently and see if you can answer questions or give info before the video does.

• Go back through the Desmos activities.

 We develop a lot of ideas in these and practice a lot of problems. See if you can recall what we learned and try the problems again.

• Rework the Independent Practice. Yes, the same ones you've already done.

 Hopefully, your previous work is clear and will make for a great step-by-step answer key.

• Do extra problems from the workbook.
